



# **Wearable Children's Underarm Thermometer**

# **Directions:**

Peel off both release liners from the back to remove thermometer and place thermometer in the Axilla (armpit)

# **Warning: Read Before Use!**

To ensure TraxIt® performs at its best, it's essential to follow all usage instructions carefully:

- Make sure the underarm area is clean and dry before application. The skin must be free of oil, hair, and powder
- Place TraxIt® deep in the arm pit under the fold and press gently for good contact.
- Correct placement is key! TraxIt must be applied directly under the child's armpit-not lower on the chest
- Close the arm and wait 3 minutes. Readings will then continue automatically for up to 48 hours

Proper placement ensures accurate and consistent temperature tracking.

Traxlt can be used on patients 6 months and older as per clinical study conducted.

#### **How to Read:**

- 1. Lift arm to read. Thereafter readings are virtually instant. Just lift the arm to take the next measurement.
- 2. Look at dot grid. The highest black dot indicates the correct temperature (see example).

#### Note:

TraxIt® will adhere to the armpit through bathing and may be left in place up to 48 hours on normal, healthy, intact skin.

### To Remove:

Gently peel off and discard. DO NOT REUSE.

Accuracy:  $\pm$  0.2 °F (maximum permissible error).

Thermometer has no temperature offset.

# **Do Not Reuse:**


